## **OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR 2010/2011 CAMARO**

The official rules and regulations of the donations are set forth below. By participating, you agree to be bound by these rules and regulations. Cody Thompson Racing's (CTR) interpretation and application of the rules and regulations shall be final.

### **Tickets**

Donation is to be set at \$20.00 per entry or \$100 per 6 entries. There will be a minimum of 2800 tickets required to be sold for the car raffle to be valid. In the event less than 2800 tickets are sold by the drawing deadline, the raffle becomes a 50/50 raffle and the bearer of the winning ticket will receive 50% of the proceeds collected after expenses and Groth Brothers Chevrolet will retain the Camaro. There will be a maximum of 3200 tickets sold regardless of when the tickets are sold out if they sell out before the drawing date. CTR assumes no responsibility for lost, late, misdirected, or non-delivered mail or other failure to deliver tickets prior to any deadline. Purchases are not tax deductible.

### **Selection of Winner**

The winning ticket will be drawn at random on or about 7:00 p.m. Saturday September 11, 2010 at Stockton 99 Speedway from all eligible donations received. Donation holders do not need to be present to win. The winner will be notified by phone, U.S. Certified Mail, and/or in person, or email, according to the contact information provided to CTR at the time of donation. The odds of winning the 2010 Camaro SS depends on the number of entries (minimum 1:2800 maximum 1:3200).

### **Eligibility**

You must be 18 years of age or older (or have consent from a parent or legal guardian and hold a valid driver's license) and a resident of the United States to donate or win the prize. All federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply. The donation is void where prohibited or restricted by law.

### **Prize**
